## **SCOPE**

The Carpathians are Europe's largest mountain range, a reservoir of biodiversity and a water tower of the region. Its waters flow to Black and Baltic See via four large river catchments, the Danube among them. The Carpathians and the Danube harbour a rich and important variety of wetland ecosystem types. Their conservation is often in conflict with other human interests. Therefore the awareness and attitude of people living their neighbourhood is their crucial for maintenance.

This training provides an opportunity for those engaged in environmental education to explore new methods and activities in education on wetlands. The training involves interactive in/out-door activities, practical field surveys conducted with the public, discussions and focus on the needs / requests of the participants.
