Carpathian Wetland Initiative

- Regional Initiative of the Ramsar Convention (RRI), launched in 2004, endorsed by Ramsar SC in 2009, one of 20 currently operating RRI in the world (4 in Europe)
- RRI are a regional mechanism to support implementation of the Convention on Wetlands and its Strategic Plan
- Memorandum of Cooperation between secretariats of the Ramsar and Carpathian Conventions (2006)
- Partnership of governments of 7 Carpathian countries, Secretariats of both Conventions, intergovernmental organisations, international partner organizations, NGOs and other entities with an interest in the Carpathian wetlands



Cooperation with the Carpathian Convention and its working groups



- Meetings of WGs - WG on Biodiversity (Apr. 2022; May 2023); WG on Sustainable Forest Management (Oct. 2022); Meeting on the GBF implementation in the Carpathian Region (March 2023) - Comments and proposals to the draft Carpathian Biodiversity Framework;
- Commenting draft decisions for the CC COP7;
- 14th CCIC Meeting (June 2023)
- Regular communication and consultations with the SCC



Cooperation with the Ramsar Convention

- European regional meetings, EU experts meetings, Standing Committee meetings (2022)
- Commenting draft resolutions, RRI Operational Guidelines and active participation at COP14 of the Ramsar Convention (Wuhan, China and Geneva, CH, Nov. 2022)
- CWI (re)endorsed as operating in the framework of the Convention on Wetlands for the intersessional period of COP14 – COP15 (Res. XIV.7)

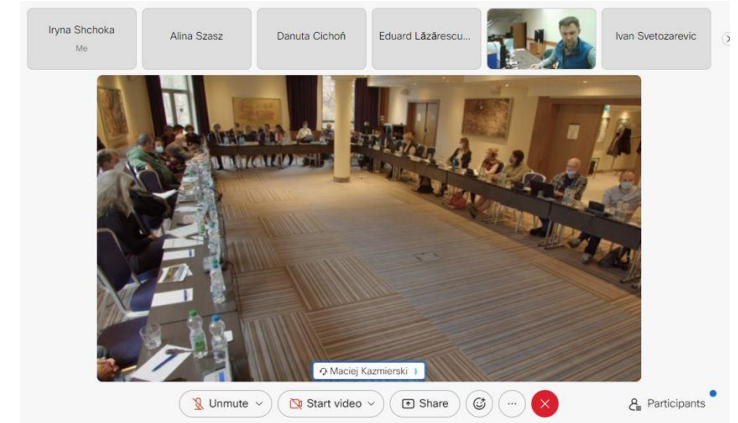

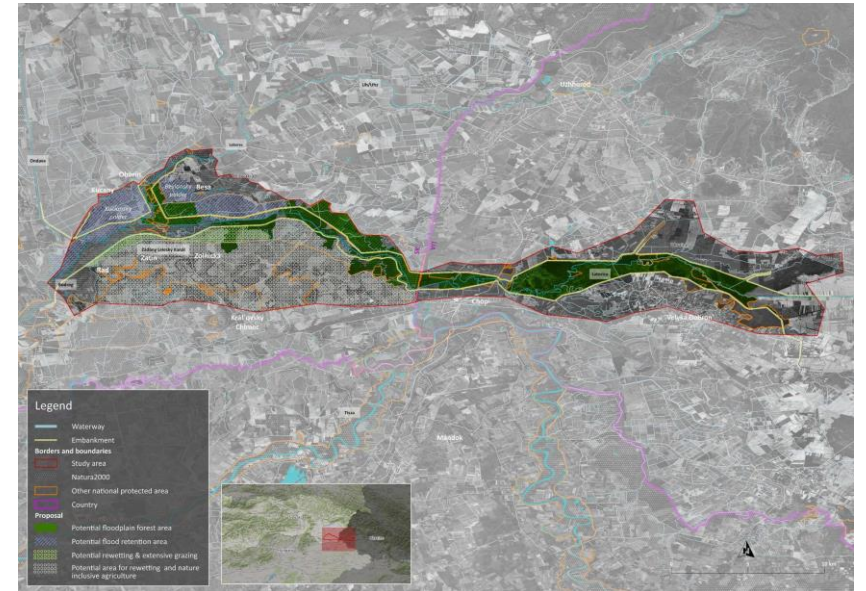
Cooperation with other networks and partners
